The Haryana Chief Minister said his State is ahead of Gujarat in development

Questioning the Gujarat model of development, Haryana Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda said on Friday that the per capita income and investment in his State is better than that in Narendra Modi's State.

He also took a dig at Gujarat Chief Minister Narendra Modi for his comments at SRCC College in Delhi University recently regarding the dependence of Delhiites on milk sourced from Gujarat.

"I don't know what the Gujarat model is. I only know the Haryana model. We are on top," Mr. Hooda said at a conclave on investment opportunities in Sonepat-Kundli.

He was replying to a query whether Haryana has any plans to adopt Gujarat model's on solar energy.

"If you talk about the Gujarat model, please talk about the basic parameters of that," he said. Mr. Hooda noted that Haryana is ahead of Gujarat in terms of per capita plan expenditure, per capita income, per capita investment and resource mobilisation.

He took a dig at Mr. Modi's claim that Delhiites drink tea made of milk produced in Gujarat, saying Haryana had more per capita milk production than Gujarat.

"Resource mobilisation is 96.5 per cent in Gujarat, in Haryana it is 192 per cent (in the 11th Plan)," the Chief Minister claimed. - PTI
